
### e-Library and Information Services








#### **Social Service**







































































# SRC International

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# **Waste Product** Management

### with Massachusetts Institute of Technology, USA

### ..... A step towards Sustainable Development

The mission started with the sharing of knowledge over e-mail and discussions through video conferences between some professors and research scholars from Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge, US and Professors from SRC Muzaffarnagar. As a result of talk, Professors from MIT, USA decided to work in partnership with SRC to design an effective waste management system in Muzaffarnagar. Indeed, the concerned branch from MIT, USA has incorporated India into their D-lab class, D-lab waste.

In the first phase, three wards have been identified in the city on the basis of socio-economic level which are: low income group, middle income group and high income group. After the video conference, a survey has been conducted of all the three identified wards and a rough analysis of the waste has been carried out by simply observing it. Now, the next phase is to prepare the waste audit sheet for the three wards. Samples were taken directly from the doorsteps of societies (communities of households). This waste audit was carried out in the mid of Dec 14 and Jan 15 in the city of Muzaffarnagar, India. MIT team reached Muzaffarnagar on 11th Jan 15 and continued the One Year project work for 2-3 weeks. The strategy was to do the sample collection in the selected wards and then use the organic waste into some usable forms. The Project is still going on.


